**LEGISLATIVE CONSULTANT UPDATE** – Lynn Briggs presented an update on current legislation:

- (1) Bill was introduced to extend the code cycle to six years – the Board of Directors has instructed Mr. Briggs to oppose this proposal on behalf of MIAM
- (2) Mechanical licensing amendments to the Forbes Act (journeymen / apprentice licensing)
- (3) Inspector Privatization in communities – the Board of Directors has instructed Mr. Briggs to remain neutral on behalf of MIAM
